HomeBASE

The Commonwealth's re-housing benefit created to provide families who are in the emergency shelter assistance system an opportunity to overcome some of the financial barriers to ending their homelessness. **Can provide** funds for first and last month's rent and security deposit in a new home, furniture, a monthly stipend to help pay rent for up to one year, utilities, travel costs and many other expenses that would otherwise prevent a family from accessing a new home. The amount and type of assistance is based on a family's needs, which will be determined through an assessment. HomeBASE additionally provides a designated stabilization worker for each family to help access community supports and offer resources to resolve issues that may arise, including tenancy-related issues.

A PLACE FOR ALL. To ensure that our membership, programs and services are accessible to everyone, the Hockomock Area YMCA offers "A Place For All" Financial Assistance Program. This income-based membership and program rate scale welcomes all individuals and families to become active members of the Y, no matter what their financial circumstances may be. We are able to offer A Place For All because of donations made through our Annual Fundraising Campaign.

The Hockomock Area YMCA's A Place for All focuses on helping our community members feel hopeful, live healthier and be connected through spirit, mind and body.

Our model ensures that every individual has access to not only membership and programs regardless of income level, but also can benefit from our mission-based programming such as food access support, holiday and year-round gift giving, our annual backpack drive, and additional community resources with a social service focus.

Financial Assistance

A Place For All uses a sliding scale rate structure that is based on gross household income designed so that all individuals are able to receive a YMCA membership and participate in programs, regardless of income level. All information is kept strictly confidential.

While our YMCA is a non-profit organization, we depend on member contributed fees to help sustain our services and mission. Therefore, 100% assistance is unusual and members pay a fee based on their ability to pay. Membership and program fee(s) will be paid through monthly bank draft or credit card only.
